How DiscountRouter collects, uses, discloses, and protects information associated with its website and Services.

This Privacy Policy applies to DiscountRouter, a United States company, and to the DiscountRouter website, APIs, routing infrastructure, software, sales interactions, and related services. It does not replace the privacy terms of third-party model providers selected by Customers.

1. Information We Collect

We collect information Customers or website visitors provide directly, information generated through use of the Services, and limited technical information necessary to operate and secure the Services.

- Name, business email address, company name, job or business information, and sales inquiry details.
- Account, authentication, contract, invoice, and payment-related information.
- Communications with sales, support, security, or legal contacts.
- Operational metadata such as request identifiers, account identifiers, selected model, token and usage quantities, timestamps, latency, response status, error codes, rate-limit events, and security events.
- Website technical data such as IP address, browser type, device type, operating system, referring page, pages viewed, and timestamps, where collected by standard web infrastructure or enabled analytics tools.

2. API Prompt and Response Content

Prompts, inputs, files, images, and other request content pass through DiscountRouter infrastructure so that the selected model provider can process the request. Responses pass back through DiscountRouter so they can be returned to the Customer.

4. How We Disclose Information

- Model providers selected by the Customer, because the selected provider must receive the request to generate a response.
- Infrastructure, authentication, monitoring, communications, payment, professional-services, and security vendors acting on our behalf.

- Professional advisers such as lawyers, accountants, auditors, insurers, and financial institutions where reasonably necessary.
- Governmental authorities or other parties where disclosure is required by law or valid legal process, or reasonably necessary to protect rights, safety, security, or the integrity of the Services.
- A buyer, investor, lender, affiliate, successor, or transaction counterparty in connection with a financing, merger, acquisition, restructuring, or sale of all or part of the business, subject to appropriate confidentiality protections where practicable.

5. Sale, Sharing, and Advertising

DiscountRouter does not sell Customer prompt or response content. DiscountRouter does not use Customer prompt or response content for targeted advertising.

If DiscountRouter later engages in activities treated as a "sale" or "sharing" of personal information under an applicable U.S. state privacy law, it will provide any required notices and opt-out mechanisms before or at the time required by law.
